

## **ABOUT the PEDAL IN THE PARK event**

This is very much a young families event designed to encourage toddlers and young children to get on their bikes whilst raising funds for their local homeless charity. The course follows a circular 4K tarmac path around the historical Sutton Park. The starting time is between 12 noon and 1pm and the last cyclist is expected back at 2pm. Simple as that!

Because this event is free we do ask people taking part to try and raise some sponsorship money for us. The more money we can raise the more vulnerable young people we can save from homelessness.

## **PEDAL IN THE PARK TERMS & CONDITIONS**

- i) People registering must be 18 years old or over, all accompanied minors and all guests must be made aware of the nature of this event. (It is a charity bike ride along 3.8 kilometre, wide tarmac path with slight undulations. There is no age limit, so there could be very young and very old people taking part.) By registering you agree that you have read the information about this event, that you understand that information, that you will abide by these terms and conditions and that you have imparted this information onto any minors and guests accompanying you.
- ii) All participants and spectators must abide by any instructions or regulations displayed or given on the day of the event by Event Officials.
- iii) All participants taking part are responsible for ensuring they and the people they have registered are medically and physically able to undergo this activity.
- iv) Participants take part at their own risk and the organisers cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage to personal effects, for personal accidents or for injury or loss to third parties, other than as a result of St Basils negligence.
- v) You must not race and if overtaking do it sensibly and with respect to other cyclist. The organisers reserve the right to stop any cyclist continuing/taking part further in the event if to do so would be potentially dangerous to other cyclists.
- vi) The event organisers are not responsible for you getting to and from the event. You must make your own travel arrangements including parking.
- vii) At the event you will be asked to hand over your signed disclaimer form. If you do not sign this form you will not be allowed to take part in the event.
- viii) St Basils reserve the right to cancel the event due to any unforeseen circumstances (i.e.) bad weather or potential harm to the participants. If this happens we will endeavour to give you as much notice as possible and reschedule the event for a later date. It is always worth checking the event page 24 hours before the event. We are guided in this decision by reports from the Met Office. If there is an AMBER

weather warning issued by the Met Office 24 hours before the event the likelihood is that we will cancel the event, so please keep looking at the webpage beforehand.

- ix) To help us promote this event professional photographers will be photographing and filming people taking part. If you do not want your image used then please take a NO PHOTOGRAPHS sticker at the start of the event and clearly display it. You understand and agree that it is your responsibility to obtain this sticker so that we can easily identify who does not want their image used.
