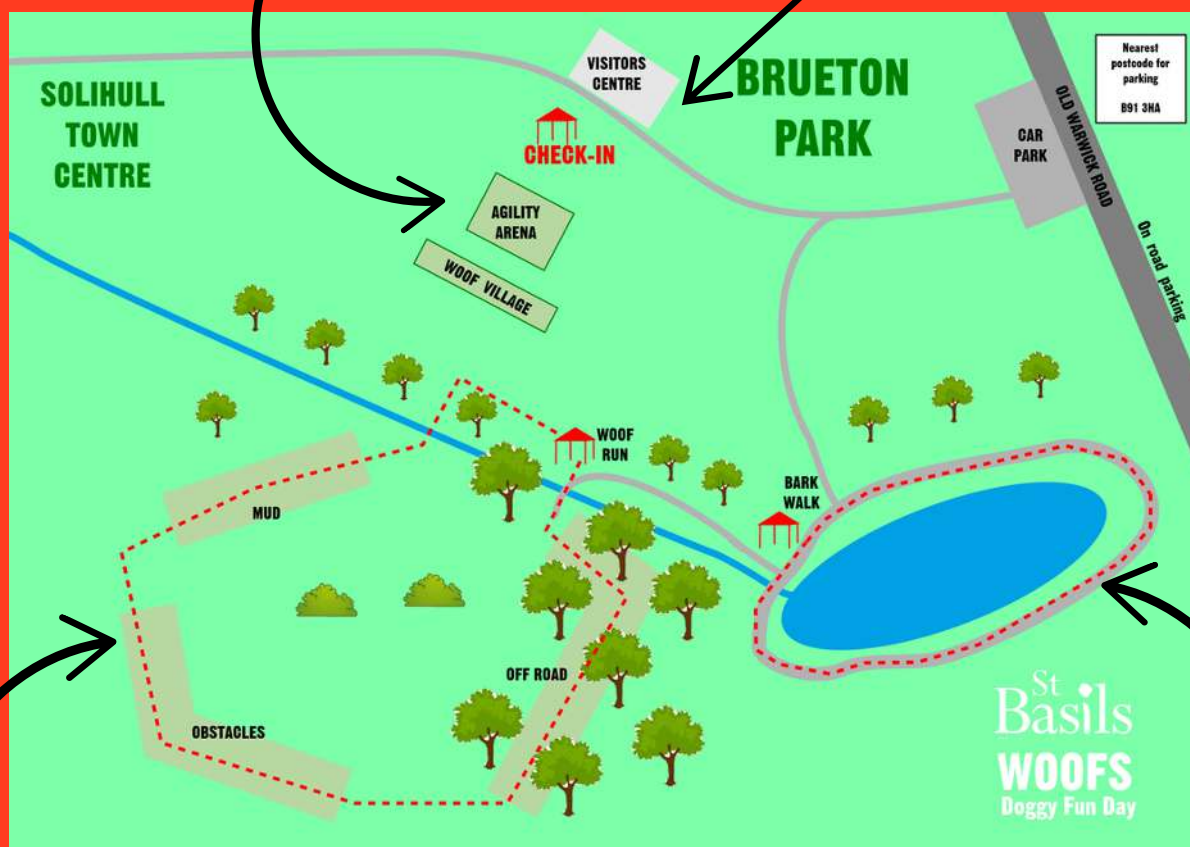
# THE COURSE

## THE ANIMAL KIND AGILITY ZONE

Get tips on dog training and try your paws at dog agility, including jumps, hoops and more

## OUTDOOR HOSE

A chance to clean off all that mud!



## THE WOOF RUN

A 1 kilometre challenge involving off road wood track, Cruft's-like obstacles and what we think is the UK's largest mud patch

## THE BARK RUN

A 700 metre walk on flat tarmac around a picturesque lake with other friendly dog-walkers



# ON THE DAY

## PARKING

Please allow plenty of time to find yourself a parking space. The places we have indicated on the map are public and may fill up quickly. The postcode for parking is **B91 3HA**.

## CHECK IN

At Brueton Park, check in at the St Basils Gazebo by the visitor center. Show your ticket to receive a wristband, which grants access to the Agility Zone, Bark Walk, and Woof Run.

## WEATHER

It's March, so wrap up warm and don't forget your wellies!

## BEST PRACTICE FOR PUPS

- If your dog doesn't fancy doing an obstacle on the Woof Run, simply go round it.
- Please bring poo bags with you and if your dog does go to the toilet, please pick it up. There will be a bin at the finish line.
- If your dog gets muddy you can hose them down outside the Visitors' Centre.
- Qualified vets are present at the Dog Village, should you wish to have your pet looked at.

## AMENITIES

Toilets, hot & cold drinks and food are available in the Visitors Centre.

## EVENT END AND PRESENTATIONS

- At the finish line, stand for your photo and your Woof Run medal.
- The **Under 2's presentation** is at 12:45pm in the Agility Zone.
- The **Over 2's presentation** is at 2:45pm in the Agility Zone.





# IMPACTS

## FUNDRAISING PAGE

We use **Enthuse** for online fundraising, which is easy to use and used by other trusted charities like *Macmillan*.

After registering for **WOOFS**, a fundraising page is **automatically** created for you, with instructions sent via email. You can access your page anytime through your Enthuse dashboard.
